Fifth Ward will begin distribution of food boxes.



"...She called him Moses, explaining, "Because I pulled him out of the water." (Ex 2:10)



Before Moses was born, Joseph's family moved from Canaan to Egypt and settled in an area called Goshen. But is there proof that Hebrew people lived in Egypt? In 1966, archaeologists exploring the Nile Delta discovered a settlement of "Asiatics," a term that Egyptians used for people from Canaan (homeland of the Hebrews). What did they find? The ruins showed a city with narrow streets and alleys and mud-brick buildings. U-shaped house plans and the walls of buildings were exactly like those houses later built by Hebrew people in Israel. They even found weapons just like the Hebrews used in ancient times. What do you think?

Did you know that according to ancient documents such as the Brooklyn Papyrus, as many as 50% of the slaves in the Nile Valley at this time had Hebrew names? Life was not fun as a slave - no wonder the Hebrews wanted to leave Egypt!
